Chantilly Retreat welcomes the holidaymaker seeking self-catering accommodation including pure relaxation and rejuvenation.

Whether you want to hire the venue for weddings, conferences, memorials, retreats, music or any other private customised events, our venue will cater for your specific needs.

Situated on the North Coast of KwaZulu-Natal, near a little village known as Zinkwazi Beach (5km from Zinkwazi Main Beach), Chantilly was once an old homestead that was part of the Victoria County. Set among magnificent old trees and rolling hills of sugar cane, it was recently converted into a captivating casual retreat.

Chantilly offers self-catering accommodation, designed to maximize the outdoor experience. The cozy bar with large television screens and a fully-fledged restaurant makes this location an ideal conference or wedding venue too. **Please note that our restaurant is only open for functions.**

The Chalet accommodation offers only self-catering.

The resort is only 80 km from Durban and is close to a variety of amenities.

The Self-catering chalets (Sleeps 2 persons per chalet):

We have 6 charming chalets, each providing the comfort of a lavish, queen-sized bed and accompanied by a kitchenette stocked with basic self-catering facilities. The ensuite bathroom consist of a bath, toilet and leads out to your private outdoor rain shower for an exhilarating experience. Large glass sliding doors reveals a splendid view from the comfort of your bed and opens onto your own private deck with a built-in braai, as well as your own bonfire pit. Each chalet has a TV with DSTV, aircon and free wi-fi.

Rates

Out of season – During the week **R1 500** per night per chalet, Weekends **R1 700** per night per chalet. A minimum of 2 nights stay.

In season (School and Public Holidays) – **R1 900** per night per chalet. A minimum of 2 nights stay - excluding Easter weekend and 16 Dec to 3 Jan – see Peak season rates below.

Peak Season (Easter weekend & 16 December to 3 January) – **R2 000** per night per Chalet with a minimum 4 nights stay over Easter weekend and 5 nights stay in December.

a Refundable Breakage deposit of **R1 500** is payable per chalet which will be paid back to you if there are no breakages.

About Zinkwazi Beach



Chantilly is 5km from Zinkwazi Beach;

Zinkwazi (the place of the fish eagle) is a small, quiet coastal village that offers an unspoilt beach paradise with a river lagoon where you can enjoy swimming, canoeing, fishing & boating. During low tide the beautiful tidal rock pools with the most beautiful marine life, provides ample pleasure for the kids. Lifeguards are present on the main beach.

On the beach you will also find the well-known Ski boat club with a bar & kitchen providing budget meals for the hungry.

During the months from June to October the whales come to visit to have their babies & during this period whales can be seen from the beach.

Zinkwazi also offers beautiful green, lush areas with indigenous plants to enjoy nature walks, a booze cruise on the lagoon & Fishing charters are also available.

There is a small convenience store, hairdresser and physiotherapist in the village.

Zinkwazi beach is 34 km North of Ballito, 57 km from King Shaka International Airport, 85km North of Durban and 646 km from Johannesburg.

Things to do around Zinkwazi:

Flag Animal Farm: in Salt Rock (38km from Zinkwazi), is a loving forever home to over 1000 Rescued animals, birds and reptiles! They offer a real farm experience where you and your family will be able to feed, love and cuddle all the beautiful animal family members.

Ballito Horse trails: Horseback riding on the beach is one of the best ways to enjoy beautiful sea views. Hop on a saddle and enjoy the beach in a new way, watch the sunrise on top of one of their majestic horses or end the day off with a tranquil trot on the beach.

Crocodile Creek: (51km from Zinkwazi) is home to over 2 000 Nile Crocodiles, Alligators and Snakes, Visit Crocodile Creek on the North Coast near Ballito and join in the adventure, learn about the fascinating Nile Crocodile, Alligators and other crocodiles. Crocodile Creek is a fantastic day outdoors for the entire family.

Ballito Farmers Market: (38km from Zinkwazi) is open every Saturday, Sunday & Public holidays. The Ballito Farmer's Market is a vibrant and exciting destination located within the green rolling hills of the KZN North Coast. The market offers a unique and entertaining experience with over 150 traders that's sure to delight visitors of all ages. With an abundance of open space, there is plenty of room for families to spread out and enjoy the fresh air and sunshine. The market offers live music performances by local artists, creating an inviting and lively atmosphere that's perfect for a day out with the family.





Things to do around Zinkwazi:

Golf:

Darnall Country Club (9km from Zinkwazi) – Darnall country club nestled within the village of Darnall since the 1930's, has a beautiful, and challenging nine-hole golf course.

Prinses Grant Golf Estate (20km from Zinkwazi) - Indulge in the ultimate golfing retreat at Prince's Grant, nestled on the captivating Sugar Coast of KwaZulu-Natal. The prestigious golf estate offers an unrivalled experience for golf enthusiasts of all levels. With lush fairways, panoramic views of the Indian Ocean & undulating greens. With panoramic views of the Indian Ocean, this development has been designed to capture the gracious colonial life-style of early Natal. The course architects, Matkovich & Hayes, designed the course to present challenges similar to those of traditional links course in Scotland, and the unsheltered fairways mounds and well shaped bunkers are reminiscent of the fabled links courses of Great Britain.

Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Big 5 game reserve: +/- 180km north of Zinkwazi you can experience One of The Finest Game Reserves South Africa Has To Offer. Cape Vidal: (164km from Zinkwazi) Cape Vidal offers a superb location between Lake St Lucia with its resident wildlife and the tidal delights of the Indian Ocean. This KwaZulu-Natal nature reserve has the best of both worlds.

Cape Vidal offers sheltered beaches, rock pools and ledges surrounded by the wetlands and coastal forest of iSimangaliso Wetland Park. Cape Vidal is wonderful for observing marine life at low tide while snorkeling.
