



CHANTILLY FARMHOUSE 2026 BROCHURE



Chantilly farmhouse offers rustic, self-catering accommodation & is situated on a 2.5ha small holding on the North Coast of KwaZulu-Natal, near a little village known as Zinkwazi Beach (5km from Zinkwazi Main Beach), adjacent to our Chantilly retreat. The house can sleep up to 16 pax, sharing (6 rooms).

Please note that the house is ONLY available for holiday and corporate self-catering accommodation and NO functions, parties, events or extra day visitors will be allowed without prior consent.

Chantilly farmhouse is only 80 km from Durban, 30mins from Ballito & 45mins from King Shaka International Airport.

The house consists of 6 bedrooms, of which 3 is an-suite, two share the communal bathroom and a dorm room that also share the communal bathroom. A Lounge with DSTV, Dining area & a Kitchen with the essentials, a gas stove, washing machine & microwave. The outside area has a veranda & swimming pool.

House layout:

Room 1 - An-suite room with a Queen bed with a sliding door exiting into the garden. The bathroom consists of a shower, toilet & basin.

Room 2 - An-suite with a King size bed, an open side room with a single bed & a sliding door exiting into the garden. The bathroom consists of a bath, shower, toilet & basin.

Room 3 - This room has a double bed and shares a communal bathroom & a sliding door exiting into the garden,

Room 4 - This room has x2 single beds, shares a communal bathroom & a sliding door exiting into the garden,

Room 5 - This is a dorm room with x1 queen size bed, x2 $\frac{3}{4}$ beds and x1 single bed – sleeps 5 people and shares the communal bathroom. It has a door exiting into the outside area,

Room 6 - An-suite room with a queen size bed, with a sliding door exiting into the garden. The bathroom consists of a shower, bath, toilet and basin.

The communal bathroom - consists of x2 toilets, x2 showers & x2 basins.



Rates (Valid Until 31 January 2027):

Out of Season - R3 000 per night. A minimum of 2 nights stay.

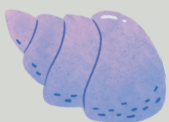
In Season - (Excluding Easter weekend and 16 Dec to 3 Jan) **R3 500** per night with a minimum of 2 nights stay.

Peak Season - (Easter weekend & 16 December to 3 January) – **R4 000** per night with a minimum 4 nights stay over Easter weekend and 5 nights stay in December.

Additional charges:

Refundable Breakage Deposit - R3 500.

Maid fee - R350 per day can be arranged.





About Zinkwazi Beach:

Zinkwazi (the place of the fish eagle) is a small, quiet coastal village that offers an unspoilt beach paradise with a river lagoon where you can enjoy swimming, canoeing, fishing & boating. During low tide the beautiful tidal rock pools with the most beautiful marine life, provides ample pleasure for the kids. Lifeguards are present on the main beach.

On the beach you will also find the well-known Ski boat club with a bar & kitchen providing budget meals for the hungry.

During the months from June to October the whales come to visit to have their babies & during this period whales can be seen from the beach.

Zinkwazi also offers beautiful green, lush areas with indigenous plants to enjoy nature walks, a booze cruise on the lagoon & Fishing charters are also available.

There is a small convenience store, hairdresser and physiotherapist in the village.

Zinkwazi beach is 34 km North of Ballito, 57 km from King Shaka International Airport, 85km North of Durban and 646 km from Johannesburg.

Things to do around Zinkwazi:

·Golf:

oDarnall Country Club (9km from Zinkwazi) – Darnall country club nestled within the village of Darnall since the 1930's, has a beautiful, and challenging nine-hole golf course.

oPrinses Grant Golf Estate (20km from Zinkwazi) - Indulge in the ultimate golfing retreat at Prince's Grant, nestled on the captivating Sugar Coast of KwaZulu-Natal. The prestigious golf estate offers an unrivalled experience for golf enthusiasts of all levels. With lush fairways, panoramic views of the Indian Ocean & undulating greens. With panoramic views of the Indian Ocean, this development has been designed to capture the gracious colonial life-style of early Natal. The course architects, Matkovich & Hayes, designed the course to present challenges similar to those of traditional links course in Scotland, and the unsheltered fairways mounds and well shaped bunkers are reminiscent of the fabled links courses of Great Britain.

·**Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Big 5 game reserve:** +/- 180km north of Zinkwazi you can experience One of The Finest Game Reserves South Africa Has To Offer. ·**Cape Vidal:** (164km from Zinkwazi) Cape Vidal offers a superb location between Lake St Lucia with its resident wildlife and the tidal delights of the Indian Ocean. This KwaZulu-Natal nature reserve has the best of both worlds. Cape Vidal offers sheltered beaches, rock pools and ledges surrounded by the wetlands and coastal forest of iSimangaliso Wetland Park. Cape Vidal is wonderful for observing marine life at low tide while snorkelling.

·**Flag Animal Farm:** in Salt Rock (38km from Zinkwazi), is a loving forever home to over 1000 Rescued animals, birds and reptiles! They offer a real farm experience where you and your family will be able to feed, love and cuddle all the beautiful animal family members.



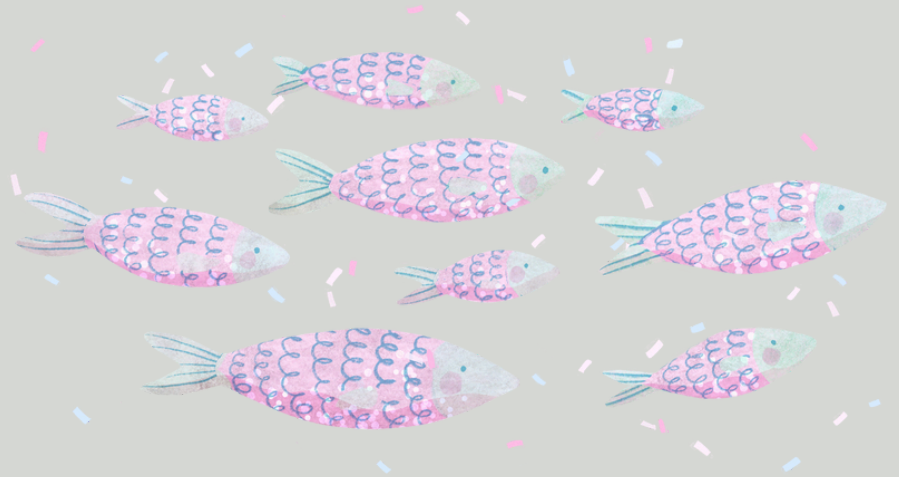
